Pastor's Message

The Garden City Community Church Members and Friends,

In October of 1930 before the Great Depression turned one year old, this religious institution came into being, and became known as The Garden City Community Church, the name affirmed in July 1931. What a time to begin life! In the year 1931 Garden City modified it's "Community Agreement... to include the newly developed Western Section of the Village", (from gardencityny.net) a place experiencing geographical expansion and numerical growth amidst an economic depression and a sea change in the geo-political world.

Like Garden City itself in 1931, The Garden City Community Church understood its purpose and embodied it's deep gladness. Ninety-two years ago the spirit of this place incarnated its *Why*. It knew it's holy vocation: it's deep and glad purpose in service to the worlds need. Curiosity, wonderment, possibility, a "yes... and" posture nourished their being and doing. *Community Church*. Such a powerful expression of *purpose*! I imagine this conversation in 1930 and 1931.

Why another Christian congregation in Garden City? *To benefit all of Garden City and partner with all of Garden City*. Why a congregational congregation? *For those who desire to offer their whole selves in the whole life of church*. For what purpose? *To be and do the way of Jesus in the midst of much want, trial, and tribulation*.

No church folk are alive today who were adults ninety-two years ago, though some of you experienced The Garden City Community Church at its vocational zenith, a zenith not defined by overflowing worship attendance or cradle to grave church school participation, or wise and charismatic leadership, though these, perhaps, were the fruit. Friends, this congregation's zenith was defined by a clarity of purpose aligned with its best gifts and resources in response to Garden City and the worlds need.

In this ninety-second, going on ninety-third year of church life, as this 2024 year begins to unfurl, in what powerful ways, I wonder, will you, church, respond to God's still speaking voice? This answer finds its source in your answer to the same: in what powerful ways, I wonder, will you, dear one, respond to God's still speaking voice? I am not inviting, with my query, *what to do* or *how to do it*. Your *doing* muscles are strong and experienced. Ready and able. I am inviting you to ponder, as if for the first time, your deep gladness, the bedrock that joys you through and through. I am inviting you to prayerful pondering without agenda, or judgement, or expectation, or plan: without nostalgia nor aspiration. Your deep gladness, joined by others, gives shape and substance to The Garden City Community Churches bedrock that joys the spirit of this place - deep gladness in service to the worlds need.

2024 begins with the Season of Epiphany - growing and learning, becoming the Season of Lent - discerning and doing. Growing and learning - discerning and doing with you, with God's help!
