#### Pastor's Message

Almost Advent and Christmas GCCCers!

First, invitations...

A family Advent / Christmas story quiz – E Blast and other places. Bring your answers to worship on December 17<sup>th</sup>. Rules: if a family, do it together. If single, do it with at least one single friend. No Bible, no Google (search engine), nor Chatgpt. It's a "quiz":).

**Join me for an after worship – after coffee time visit. Or Monday – Thursday** – In your home – or elsewhere – for a meal or not -Perhaps you will tell me about yourself, and about you and God, and about you and GCCC...

**Read this monthly newsletter.** It's one of the places where I will weave inspiration, provocation (in a good way), and narrative for you and GCCC: the life of faith and ministry and mission in the near-term and the far-term and habits of the heart past, present, and emerging.

Attend worship weekly. Here — on-line or in-person - beside advancing the content named just above, it's the one place to give and receive together, where GCCCers and those giving thought to joining with GCCC give each other their heart. Worship. God gives us their heart. We give God our heart. We give and receive one another's heart. Wonderful! Vulnerable! Heart-mending and heart-breaking. Life-giving and life-sustaining. Better than any movie, really!

Friends, GCCC and the 1<sup>st</sup> Century Christian church share a journey narrative; you, as did they, are walking a path not trod for a generation, or more. You, as did they, grieve what once was. You, as did they, are glad for those who lead and wonder what the future will bring. You, as did they, "believe in...God, Eternal Spirit, God of our Savior Jesus Christ and our God, and to your deeds we testify..." (from Preamble, page 1, GCCC By-Laws, 1 January 2019) You, as they, are living in a present moment unlike any other before. You, as they, are praying "not my will, but your will be done, O God." You, as did they, embark on a journey with one another and with God.

Twenty-five to thirty years are often thought the span of a generation. A Senior Pastor can, in that span, hold an infant in their arms at baptism, confirm that teenager and welcome them into the congregation, stand before them as they exchange vows on their wedding day, and baptize the infant they offer for baptism. Some of you have participated in GCCC ministry during a season longer than thirty years, before a time when Jim was Associate, succeeding to Senior Pastor, then Lynn as Associate succeeding to Senior Pastor. For the first time in more than a generation, the spirit of GCCC, and some of you, enter a season without an Associate succeeding to Senior Pastor. Instead, me ....

GCCC, your emotional and spiritual muscles are stretching and growing. And as an athlete knows, growing muscles ache and pain. They need effort and recovery, nourishment and rest. They need regular and constant exercise. They do not grow, generally for their own sake. Advent, a "little Lent," prepares us for pondering the wonder and goodness of God-with-Us. Advent serves as our first practice – leaning into one another as Intentional Interim Senior Pastor and people – together we prepare for our emotional and spiritual work.

Edgar and Peter Schein observed that only one essential posture and practice grounds *humble leaders* and *humble leadership*: **personization**. It's a word they coined to describe what I have described as generous hospitality, respectful communality and glad collaboration. Lately you may have heard me offer this metaphor: these gospel graces are about sharing and giving ones' heart and receiving another's heart. Jesus described Schein's *personization* as loving God with one's whole self, and loving the stranger, enemy and neighbor with the same measure of love one loves on oneself.

Join me in practicing this life and faith posture. Open. Vulnerable. Intentional. Leaning in will prepare you and the spirit of GCCC for every eventuality, no matter what; even a Mary - cousin of Elizabeth - not yet pregnant by holy Spirit – God conversation moment. I am glad to be with. In anticipation of visiting and worshipping together ... A blessed Advent one and all!


